
HOW TO HAVE AND ORGANIZED AND SUCCESSFUL MOVE

How to Have an Organized and Successful Move

Co through and number. Chie access denote an call
Go through and purge. Give away, donate or sell.
Decide who is going to do the packing.
Contact 3 moving companies and get firm quotes.
Set aside any items you will need during the process.
Put in a change of address at the Post Office (online)
Notilfy all magazines and publications.
Cancel utilities - water, sewer, electric, gas, cable, trash, security, etc.
Set up new utilities.
Buy boxes, tape and packing paper.
Figure out what to do with the pets during the process.
Who is going to take care of the children during the process.
Video everything. Inside drawers, closets, boxes.
Measure anything you are moving so you know if it fits!
Arrange cleaning people to clean if you are using them.
Arrange the pick up and drop off of keys.
Book hotels and flights if needed.
Does your new house need cleaned?
If renting, schedule walk thru with landlord. Have previous damaged list ready for comparison

Your new destination:

Register your vehicles, boats, etc.
Get your new drivers license - usually have 30 days.
Register your children in school.
Find a vet - just in case.
